MCASA's Sexual Assault Legal Institute (SALI) provides legal services to survivors of sexual violence. SALI attorneys and staff are here for you and continue to provide services to our clients. Staff is available to answer legal questions, conduct intakes for first-time callers in need of legal representation and provide safety planning. Attorneys are still attending emergency hearings, virtual or otherwise, with clients. Maryland Commissioners' Offices and Courts are still hearing and granting Peace and Protective Orders and Maryland Courts are still hearing family law emergencies.
